### **2021 Domaine Des REMIZIERES Crozes-Hermitage Origine – 88pts**

“The 2021 Crozes-Hermitage Origine has more smoky red and black fruits as well as some meaty, iron, and peppery nuances. It too is medium-bodied, has a nicely balanced, enjoyable mouthfeel, and a good finish.”

### **2021 Domaine Des REMIZIERES Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Particulière Rouge – 88pts**

« The 2021 Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Particulière has plenty to like, with a deeper ruby/plum color, notes of ripe red and black fruits, spice, and peppery herbs, medium body, and soft tannins. It's a delicious, balanced, impeccably made Croze to drink over the coming 3-5 years. »

### **2021 Domaine Des REMIZIERES Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Particulière Blanc – 89pts**

« Bright citrus, honeyed, minty herbs, and some obvious minerality all emerge from the 2021 Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Particulière Blanc, a medium-bodied, juicy, vibrant white from this terrific estate that's perfect for drinking over the coming 2-4 years. »

### **2020 Domaine Des Remizières Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Christophe Rouge – 93pts**

“Smoky red and black fruits, spicy wood, graphite, and ground pepper all emerge from the 2020 Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Christophe, another impeccably made wine from this team. With medium to full-bodied richness and ripe, polished, yet building tannins, it's going to evolve gracefully for at least a decade.”

### **2021 Domaine Des REMIZIERES Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Christophe Rouge – 88-90pts**

“The 2021 Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Christophe brings more density and depth, with a touch of cassis in its darker fruits as well as peppery herbs, spicy wood, and graphite aromatics. Medium-bodied, nicely concentrated, and balanced, it has outstanding potential, and that's saying something in this vintage for Crozes. »

### **2021 Domaine Des REMIZIERES Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Christophe Blanc – 91pts**

“The 2021 Crozes-Hermitage Cuvée Christophe Blanc shows the fresher style of the vintage and has perfumed peach and tangerine notes as well as some background honeyed flower, toast, and spicy nuances. Medium-bodied, nicely textured, and balanced, it's a terrific white in the vintage that's going to shine on the dinner table. »

### **2020 Domaine Des REMIZIERES Hermitage Cuvée Emilie – 94+pts**

« I always love this cuvée from this estate, and their 2020 Hermitage Cuvée Emilie is a beauty, offering full-bodied aromas and flavors of cassis, graphite, burning embers, and classy background oak. I love its purity, it has notable freshness and balance, and a great finish. It has some up-front appeal (especially with a solid decant), but this is best forgotten for 4-5 years. It should have two decades of overall longevity. »

### **2021 Domaine Des REMIZIERES Hermitage Cuvée Emilie – 89-92pts**

The 2021 Hermitage Cuvée Emilie is solid in the vintage, revealing a deep purple hue to go with smoky black fruits, scorched earth, and peppery notes. It's medium-bodied, has ripe tannins, and the fresher, brighter style of the vintage front and center.

**2021 Domaine Des REMIZIERES Hermitage Cuvée Emilie Blanc – 94pts**

« Exotic tropical fruits, honeyed melon, and toasted bread notes define the 2021 Hermitage Cuvée Emilie Blanc, a richer, medium-bodied, almost structured white with good overall balance and outstanding length. It's tight and reserved and needs 2-3 years of bottle age, but this is a seriously good white, especially in the vintage. Bravo. »

**2020 Domaine Des REMIZIERES Saint Joseph – 91-93+pts**

« Not yet bottled, the 2020 Saint Joseph sports a dense purple hue as well as impressive intensity in its darker, almost blue fruits as well as notes of peppery herbs, incense, and spice. With nicely integrated background oak, medium to full body, ripe tannins, and terrific overall balance, it should be a long-lived Saint Joseph, but it warrants short-term cellaring. »

**2020 Les REMIZIERES Cornas – 93pts**

“Another rocking release from this estate is the 2020 Cornas, a pure, medium to full-bodied, concentrated effort that has terrific purity in its assorted darker red and blue fruits as well as notes of iron, bouquet garni, and pepper. It offers nicely integrated oak, ripe tannins, and a great finish.”

**2021 Les REMIZIERES Cornas – 90-92pts**

“The 2021 Cornas is rock-solid and offers more pleasure than most in the vintage. Ripe darker cherries, spicy wood, dried herbs, and some floral notes all give way to a medium-bodied Cornas with ripe tannins and good overall balance.”
